FORBIDDEN BEHAVIORS

Current regulations imposed by the Venice City Council Municipal Police prohibit specific behaviors, in order **to preserve urban cleanliness and landscape, and also for reasons of safety and public hygiene.**

The violation of regulations below implicates the application of **administrative fines – from €25 to €500.**



Fine: 200 €

Except in specifically designated areas, **IT'S FORBIDDEN TO SIT in St. Mark's Square and in Piazzetta dei Leoncini**, under the arcades and on the steps of the Procuratie Nuove, the Napoleonic Wing, the Sansovino Library, beneath the arcades of the Ducal Palace, in the Piazzetta San Marco and its jetty.

“No standing at any time” – even to consume food and drink, with the exclusion of restaurants, cafés, and refreshment areas.

IT IS FORBIDDEN TO LITTER PUBLIC AREAS (i.e. throw papers, cans, bottles and any type of solid or liquid refuse and/or hinder circulation/traffic on bridges and alleys.



Fine: 450 euro

IT IS FORBIDDEN TO SWIM, DIVE OR IMMERSE oneself in streams, canals, whether public or private, and in St. Mark's Basin, or in any water spot near any inhabited municipal area.



Fine: from 100 € to 200 €

IT IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN TO LITTER OR THROW GARBAGE in public areas, or places open to the public in the City of Venice.



Fine: 200 €

IT IS FORBIDDEN for both males and females, to WALK in city streets, stand at any time in public places and establishments, travel with public or private means while BARE-CHESTED OR WEARING SWIMWEAR.



Fine: from 50 € to 200 €

For health reasons and to protect the artistic heritage, it is **FORBIDDEN TO GIVE, LEAVE and ABANDON FOOD** on alleys, in squares or other public places, in streams and canals in the City of Venice.



Fine: 100 €

BICYCLES ARE FORBIDDEN (even when only lead by hand) in Venice city Centre – excepting when used by city residents and children up to 8yrs of age.



Fine: 50 €

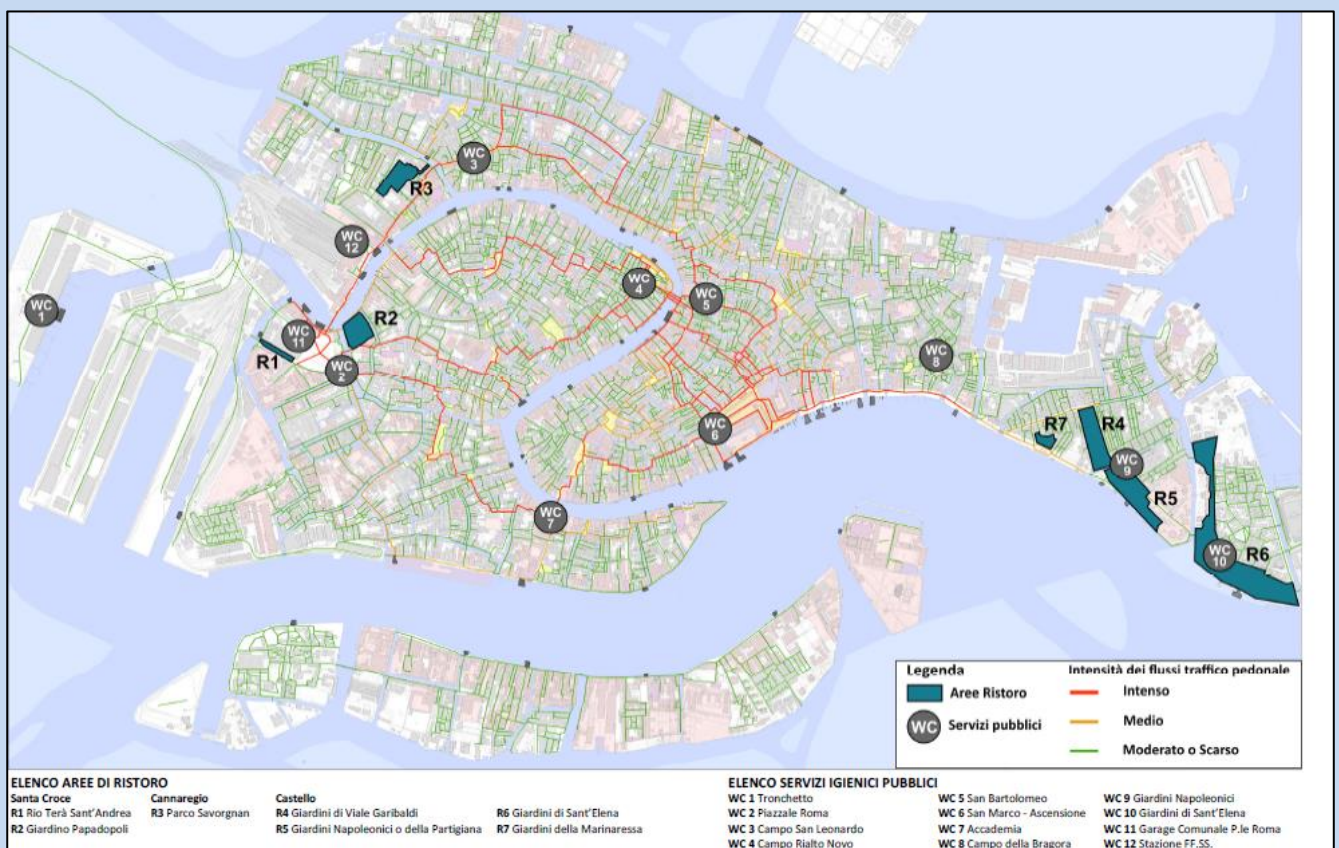
IT IS FORBIDDEN TO CAMP or stand at any time with camping equipment in any part of the City of Venice.

Please, respect these simple rules in order to avoid to damage Venice and giving a better experience also to others tourists, that like you, want to enjoy the city.

Good rules for the responsible visitor

These are simple advices to **enjoy Venice** in a **sustainable way**. Please follow the indications in order to protect the city and its environmental.

- 1- **Walk on the right**, do not stand at any time on bridges, do not even lead bikes by hand.
- 2- Steps of churches, bridges, wells, monuments and banks of streams, canals etc. **ARE NOT PICNIC AREAS**. Please use the public gardens for this necessity. Consult the map below:

- 3- St. Mark's Square is a monumental site and excluding pertinent bars and restaurants, **IT IS FORBIDDEN TO STAND AT ANY TIME IN ORDER TO CONSUME FOOD OR DRINK**.
- 4- Venice is a city of art: **IT IS FORBIDDEN TO CAMP**, walk about in swimwear, dive and SWIM. The beaches at Lido and Pellestrina can be easily reached by public transports or taxi.

- 5- **RESPECT THE ENVIRONMENT AND ARTISTIC WEALTH:** do not litter, do not vandalize with graffiti, or padlocks. Do not give food to the pigeons.
